

Maintenance Instructions

FINE ART FINISH/PROTECTIVE COATING

Note: Fine art finishes/patina's are done by hand on an individual basis. No 2 will be identical. Color chips and photos of individual patina's are a close facimile to color and pattern. Your sink is one of a kind.

- 1. Do not <u>use</u> abrasive cleaners or pads on your sink. We recommend using a <u>soft cloth</u> <u>or sponge</u> and a non abrasive cleaner such as "<u>PURE CITRUS</u>" to clean your sink.
- Your sink has a special coating to ensure the life of the finish. We recommend waxing your sink occasionally to help prevent scuffing.
 Car or paste waxes "we prefer Turtle Wax ICE " work great . Apply with a soft cloth, allow to dry, then buff to a shine.
- 3. If the coating becomes scratched or marred there are compounds that can be used to buff them out. Turtle wax makes compounds of various grits which work great at removing scuff and swirl marks. These can be purchased at most automotive store.
- 4. Take care not to drop sharp or heavy objects into your sink. Though sinks are solid cast metal the coating can be bruised and damaged. Our coatings are the best and most durable the market can offer they are not invincible.
