Maintenance Instructions

OIL RUBBED BRONZE

Congratulations on the purchase of your bronze sink. Oil rubbed bronze will darken and change over time. Please follow maintenance instructions to prevent undesirable change. Bronze is a durable but soft metal , it can be scratched and or scuffed fairly easily. Care should be taken as to how the sink is treated. The finish is susceptible to the environment it is exposed to. Sunlight and water quality are two factors which can bring about change.

Sinks should be rinsed then dried after each use & waxed weekly.

Do **NOT** allow toothpaste or other chemicals to dry on sink.

Do **NOT** use abrasive cleaners or polishes on traditional bronze finish.
(These will damage the patina.)

Clean with a soft wet cloth and a small amount of dish soap, rinse well then dry with soft cloth.

Wax is a temporary barrier ,wax regularly to protect your sinks finish.

Unmaintained sinks (if typical cleaning is ineffective) can be buffed with a very fine grit steel wool pad (preferably 000). Buff gently to remove stains, to much force will remove an undesirable amount of finish. We recommend using a little **liquid** car wax or TURTLE Wax (ICE) as you are attempting to remove any stains. Rinse, dry then wax and buff. Wax should be allowed time to bond to sink before buffing.

We do NOT warranty the oil rubbed bronze finish after installation.
