

SATIN NICKEL

This is all the maintenance most consumers will need to provide for the care of their sink. Satin Nickel is as easily maintained as stainless steel.

Bronze is a durable but soft metal, it can be scratched and or scuffed. Care should be taken as to how the sink is treated. We recommend for ordinary cleaning, using a soft cloth and a mild cleanser, rinse with warm water, dry with a soft cloth. Wax after each cleaning to prevent discoloration and wear.

For harsher water types these steps may be necessary:

Tarnish or Water Spots

Satin finished sinks should be dried out after each use. Use Turtle wax (ICE) to prevent spotting. If spotting or tarnishing occurs it can be easily removed with a maroon or mild scotch brite pad (available at any hardware store).

Surface Scuff & Mild Scratches

Scuff marks and scratches can be removed with various abrasives and compounds. Typically a maroon scotch brite pad is a "fix all " for light scratches and scuffing.

Deep Scratches

A heavier grit scotch brite pad will take out scratches the maroon pad cannot handle. It is highly unlikely your sink could be damaged beyond your means of repair.
